SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT TO NBAA EXAMINATION CANDIDATES

RE: MINOR CHANGES FOR ATEC I, FOUNDATION AND INTERMEDIATE LEVELS EXAMINATION STRUCTURE.

Esteemed candidates, kindly be informed that the NBAA Governing Board during its 170th Ordinary meeting held on 22nd December 2016 made the following minor changes in the examination structure for the above mentioned examination levels with effect from May 2017 examination session:

ACCOUNTING TECHNICIAN LEVEL I

In the Accounting Technician level I, the two subjects that were having thirty objective questions have been reduced to twenty questions to carry the weight of **forty marks**. In this case there will be **three Conversional questions** carrying twenty marks each. Subjects involved in this level are; **T01-Book-keeping and Accounts** and **T03- Introduction to Information and Communication Technology** subjects only.

FOUNDATION LEVEL

In the Foundation level, the two subjects that were having thirty objective questions have been downsized to twenty questions to carry the weight of **forty marks**. In this case there will be **three Conversional questions** carrying twenty marks each. Subjects involved in this level are **A1- Quantitative Techniques** and **A2- Business and Management**.

INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

In the Intermediate level the number of questions has been reduced to **six questions** from seven and a candidate shall be required to **answer five questions** only out of six questions. **Question one will remain to be a compulsory question as usual.**

ALL the remaining subjects in each examination levels, shall maintain the same structure as it was before.
