



MID EXAMINATIONS FEBRUARY 2017

The NBAA Governing Board in its 2nd extra-ordinary meeting held on 29th December 2014 approved among other things the conduct of mid-examinations in the months of February and August. These examinations will be administered for three subjects namely: - A5: Business Law, B4: Public Finance and Taxation I and C4: Public Finance and Taxation II. The aim of introducing these examinations is to allow flexibility to those who are required by the law to register and sit for these examination papers at their convenience. The Education and Training By-laws of 2014 requires any person having a foreign Accountancy qualification outside East Africa to sit and pass the above mentioned examination papers before granted work permit or certificate to practice in Tanzania.

Also NBAA candidates who have remained with any of those subjects will be allowed to register and sit for Mid-Examinations. A candidate who would like to apply for these examinations must have cleared all papers in the respective level except A5 Business Law (Foundation Level), B4 Public Finance and Taxation I (Intermediate Level) or C4 Public Finance and Taxation II (Final Level). For February 2017, Mid-Examinations will be conducted on Tuesday 21st and Wednesday 22nd February 2017 at NBAA Mhasibu House Function Hall.

Examination fees are as follows:-

NBAA candidates who would like to clear their papers under mid-examinations shall be required to apply using *Application for Mid-examinations Entry Forms*. Those with

foreign CPA qualifications shall be required to fill the following two forms which are available in the website. Application for *Candidacy Registration for Foreign Qualifications* and *Application for Mid-Examinations Entry Form*. Deadline for registration is Friday 17th February 2017.
