NEW EXEMPTIONS GRANTED BY THE BOARD

We would like to inform our esteemed customers that the Governing Board at its 166th Ordinary meeting which was held on Tuesday 22nd December 2015 approved the holders of the following qualifications to start Board's examinations at the Accounting Technician Level II:

- Holders of Advanced Level Secondary Education who have pursued Economics, Commerce and Accountancy and other commercial biased combinations (with at least one principal pass and a subsidiary at A-Level Secondary Education and a pass in Mathematics and English Language at O-Level Secondary Education) to start Board's examinations at Accounting Technician Examinations Level II.
- Holders of Advanced Level Secondary Education who have pursued Commerce and Bookkeeping subjects at Ordinary Level Secondary Education to start Board's examinations at Accounting Technician Level II. They must have pass grades in these subjects and at least a pass in Mathematics at O-Level secondary education.
- Holders of Certificate of Accounting (NTA Level 4) are eligible to start Board's examinations at Accounting Technician Level II. Holders of certificates to be exempted are only those who have pass grades in Mathematics and English Language at O-Level secondary school examinations.

These exemptions are effective from May 2016 examinations
