BY-LAWS

(Made under section 45)

THE ACCOUNTANTS AND AUDITORS(PRACTISING) (AMENDMENT) BY-LAWS, 2024

Citation

GN. No. 487 of 2023 1. These By-Laws may be cited as the Accountants and Auditors (Practising) (Amendment) By-Laws, 2024 and shall be read as one with the Accountants and Auditors (Practising) By-Laws, hereinafter referred to as the "principal By-Laws".

Amendment of paragraph 3

2. The principal By-Laws are amended in paragraph 3 by deleting the definitions of the terms "certificate of registration" and "Firm".

Amendment of paragraph 31

3. The principal By-Laws are amended in paragraph 31 by deleting figure "33" and substituting for it figure "32".

Amendment of paragraph 32

4. The principal By-Laws are amended by deleting paragraph 32 and substituting for it the following:

"Cessation of membership

- **32.-**(1) The membership of the registered members shall cease upon occurrence of any of the following:
 - (a) withdrawal of certificate of registration;
 - (b) transfer of member to another register or reclassification of registration;
 - (c) death of a member;
 - (d) bankruptcy or insolvency proceedings against a member;
 - (e) serious and long-term illness

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which makes a member incapable of performing his duties; or

- (f) permanent insanity.
- (2) Upon cessation of membership under subparagraph (1), any existing certificate of practice issued shall be returned to the Board for cancellation.
- (3) Subject to section 21 of the Act, upon cessation, a person who ceases to be a member shall hand over any existing appointment to a firm mentioned in the arrangements submitted to the Board for the continuity of the assignments."

Amendment of paragraph 34

5. The principal By-Laws are amended in paragraph 34 by adding immediately after subparagraph (i) the following closing phrase:

"commits an offence and on conviction shall be liable to-

- (i) de-registration from the membership of the firm; or
- (ii) suspension for a period of not less than two years.".

Addition of new paragraph 35

6. The principal By-Laws are amended by adding immediately after paragraph 34 the following:

"Procedure for Appeal

GN. No. 1 of 2024

35. A person who is aggrieved by any decision of the Board under these By-Laws may appeal to the Appeals Board in accordance with the Accountants and Auditors (Appeals Board) Rules.".

Accountants and Auditors (Practising) (Amendment)

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Renumbering of paragraph 35

7. The principal By-Laws are amended by renumbering paragraph 35 as paragraph 36.
